On June 30, 2009, the Bureau of Land Management Humboldt River Field Office received your two Notices of Intent to Conduct Geothermal Resource Exploration Operations (NOIs). Additional information was requested by this office and received on July 7, 2009. The NOIs propose a Spartan Magnetotelluric (MT) and a 3-D Resistivity Mapping (E-Scan) survey in T. 25 N., R. 35 E., sections 1-4, 9-16, 21-24; T. 25 N., R. 36 E., sections 4-8, and 18; T. 26 N., R. 35 E., sections 25-27 and 33-36; T. 26 N., R. 36 E., sections 28-33, MDB&M., Pershing County, Nevada. The activities described in your NOIs will result in negligible disturbance and this office has determined them to be casual use per 43 CFR 3200.1. Therefore NOIs are not required and you may proceed with the MT and E-Scan surveys.
